





樹靈塔 Tree Spirit Pagoda

建次民國24年(1935年),日人因開發阿里山 大量砍伐樹木,感於有生之物皆具靈性,乃 豎塔以慰其靈,其地基一圖圖代表樹木年籍 (一轄500年),旁刻狼代表鋸木痕跡。

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Japanese erected it in 1935. The reason behind was that they had been logging the surrounding mountain ranges on a great scale and they believed all organisms should possess spirits of some sorts. The pagoda was supposed to affer wishful comfort toward those hurt tree spirits suffering from their ruthless logging behavior. The base ground of this building was decorated with many symbolic concentric circles that represented the annual rings (500 years for each ring) of a tree. On its surroundings there are cutting imprints denoting the impression of sawing into the wood.

1935年、日本人が阿里山を開発し大量の樹木を伐 探した際に、生き物には皆、魂があるとの考えか ら、この塔を建立し樹木の豊を慰めた。一つ一つ の輪が年輪を表している。(一つの輪が500年)、脇 に刻まれている跡は伐採の際の鋸の錦。
